

## A Tour of Røsnæs

At Røsnæs you may enjoy magnificent commons, precipitous cliffs, woods, sea and space. You will find breathtaking views of the sea and the landscape. A Tour of Røsnæs is a route that will take you through the area of natural beauty via 10 landmarks. 2 of the 10, The Nature Room and The Maritime Activity House in the harbor of Nyby, are real buildings. The other landmarks are small wooden stops that will put the landscape into perspective and tell you a story about a particular spot. Common to all the landmarks is the fact that they inspire activities and experiences in the surrounding landscape.

On the tour you will also find 5 landmarks that show and tell about places where J.Th. Lundbye painted.

Røsnæs Rundt is a collaboration among The Development and Residents' Association of Røsnæs, The Spectrum Architects and The Municipality of Kalundborg.

## 21 The Lighthouse of Røsnæs

The lighthouse was built in 1844-46 at the place of a historical defence fortification. Inside the lighthouse you will find an exhibition. Among other things, the exhibition will tell you about the wars the lighthouse has played a part in. In Café Fyret you can buy coffee, cake, ice cream etc. It is Bo og Aktivitet in the municipality of Kalundborg that takes care of the lighthouse and the café on working days while volunteers from The Development and Residents' Association of Røsnæs look after them during weekends.

## Wine-producing Røsnæs

On Røsnæs you will find 4 vineyards that produce wine on approximately 18 hectares and have an annual output of some 75,000 bottles. Røsnæs is the leading wine district in Denmark and stands for approximately 20% of Danish wine production. The terrain and climate of Røsnæs is ideal for wine-growing. The nearly 20,000 years old lateral moraine contains a unique blend of sand, stone, clay and lime on top of 50 million years old layers of plastic clay, which can hold large amounts of water. The steep, south-facing slopes have a mild climate thanks to the sea and Røsnæs has a hotter and drier climate compared to the average in Denmark. The wine growers on Røsnæs focus particularly on organic white wine and top-class sparkling wine.

## Welcome to Røsnæs, part of Denmark's Natural Treasures

The Røsnæs peninsula protrudes a good 15 km out in the Great Belt after having been pushed up by the sea during the last ice age more than 15,000 years ago. It has become what we call a moraine landscape - heaps of soil, sand, stone and gravel, which the ice from the ice age has pushed. The landscape here lies in the driest and sunniest climate belt in Denmark. And this provides special conditions for nature, especially in the south-facing slopes, which are marvellously revealed in all the plants and flowers that we otherwise typically find further south or east in the steppe landscape of Europe. Røsnæs is in all ways an unforgettable nature experience.

## In the footsteps of J. Th. Lundbye

J. Th. Lundbye was born in Kalundborg and he is one of the most famous Danish painters. Visit five of the places, where he used to paint his pictures on Røsnæs, read or listen to the texts and see plenty of pictures by activating the QR codes placed at every landmark.
